International Investment and Multinational Enterprises: Responsibility of Parent Companies for their Subsidiaries, O.E.C.D., Paris, 1980. Reports the results of a survey on the legal situation in Member Countries.

Canadian Industrial Organization and Policy, by Christopher Green, McGraw-Hill Ryerson, Toronto, 1980, 331 pages. This is the first systematic treatment of industrial organization in a Canadian setting to appear. It will probably be a standard text for economics undergraduate courses on the subject for some years, and it will be of interest to others who want a synoptic treatment of the field. "The book is clearly designed to present the facts of Canadian market structure, behaviour, performance and public policies toward business, with just enough theory to meet the students' basic needs." There is a chapter on Canadian competition policy legislation, jurisprudence and proposals for reform.

Second Edition, Industrial Market Structure and Economic Performance, by F.M. Scherer. Rand McNally College Publishing Co., Chicago, 1980, 632 pages. This is an authoritative text on what the author describes as a state of the art survey. The first edition, which was published in 1970, was a widely used under-graduate text and was frequently cited in courts and before regulatory tribunals. According to the author, more than half the book has been completely rewritten. He states that the book is intended to be accessible "to well motivated undergraduates and others with no more training than a basic price theory course...An abundance of footnotes provides counterpoint for the more advanced or ambitious reader."
