

OBITUARY

Albert (Ab) Spence Whiteley, M.A., on March 19, 1984 in his 81st year. He is survived by his wife, Marion, his son, Hugh, two grandsons, his sister and his brother.

Mr. Whiteley devoted by far the greater part of his professional life to the administration of the Combines Investigation Act. His contribution to the administration and development of policy in his chosen field was immense. After pursuing his economic studies in Canada, the United States and Switzerland, Mr. Whiteley entered the federal public service in 1931 where he served successively with the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, the Royal Commission on Price Spreads and the Royal Commission on Textiles. In 1937 he joined the small staff of the Combines Investigation Commission, the predecessor of the present Bureau of Competition Policy. The work of the Commission was suspended during World War II, during which time Mr. Whiteley served as economic adviser in the Wartime Prices and Trade Board. The Commission was reactivated in 1946 and Mr. Whiteley was appointed Deputy Commissioner. He became a Member of the Restrictive Trade Practices Commission on its creation in 1952 where he served for a ten-year term. After a lapse of four years which included an assignment as Canadian Consul General in Seattle, Mr. Whiteley rejoined the Restrictive Trade Practices Commission as a Member in 1966, where he remained until his retirement in 1966.
