**BRUCE M. GRAHAM** is a partner in the Toronto office of the law firm Smith Lyons and practices primarily in the area of competition/antitrust law. Admitted to the Ontario Bar in 1978, he worked in the Competition Bureau for two years before joining Smith Lyons in 1980. He is a graduate of the University of Chicago Law School (LL.M.-1976, antitrust and regulated industries), Dalhousie Law School (LL.B.-1975) and Acadia University (Hons. Mr. Hunter was the Editor-in-Chief of the International Bar Association newsletter *Antitrust and Trade Law UPDATE* (1986-1992) and was Editor-in-Chief of the *Canadian Competition Policy Record* (1986-1992). He is the author of numerous articles and publications on competition and trade law.

**JAMES B. MUSGROVE** is a partner in the Toronto office of the law firm Lang Michener and practices in the area of competition law, anti-dumping law and commercial litigation. He advises on antitrust matters, mergers, misleading advertising and has made regular representations and submissions to the Competition Bureau.
